Course Description:

This course introduces law students to the main foreign direct investment (FDI) vehicles in China, such as equity joint ventures, contractual joint ventures, wholly foreign-owned enterprises, limited liability companies, Foreign-Invested Investment (FII) Companies, partnership as well as Mergers & Acquisitions. It provides law students with a critical, accurate and updated understanding of the FDI regulatory regime, including industrial and regional policies, national and local laws and regulations, Sino-foreign BITs, and international conventions, as well as the relationship between the special foreign investment laws and other general laws. Emphasis is given to aspects of FDI laws and regulations that are especially pertinent to labor issues, antitrust, tax, and dispute

resolution, etc.
